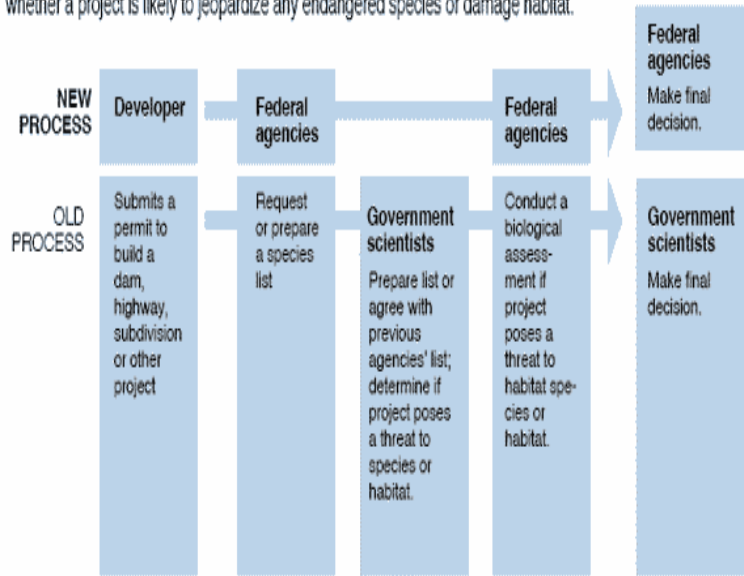


Endangered And Other Protected Species: Federal Law And Regulation
