Indeed, all the other aspects of Arminianism listed above are the subject of current research; research that owes a considerable debt to the stimulus provided by Tyacke's work and the controversy it has provoked. Whatever direction that research takes, it cannot help but build on the foundations provided by Tyacke's book. It is a groundbreaking study and an outstanding and meticulous work of scholarship.

Politics without Parliaments, 1629-1640. By ESTHER S. COPE. London: Allen & Unwin, 1987. Pp. xiii + 251. \$29.95.

In the past twenty years, scholarship in the field of English local government has been, to say the very least, prolific. The pioneering work of Thomas Barnes, Alan Everitt, John Morrill, David Underdown, and Anthony Fletcher on the county communities of Somerset, Kent, Cheshire, and Sussex, to name only a few, has spawned something akin to a major growth industry in local studies. Even in the last half-dozen years or so we have been offered major new historical surveys of the counties of Hertfordshire, Cheshire, Lincolnshire, Hampshire, and Devonshire.¹ This enthusiastic interest in provincial history has also generated considerable research on local government institutions. No less than three major studies on the Stuart justices of the peace have appeared in recent years, to add to such works as Professor Cockburn's on the Assizes (1972) and Dr. Morrill's on the Cheshire
